FINAL JUDGMENT


THIS CAUSE having come before the Court upon Final Hearing, the Court having heard testimony, reviewed and considered the evidence submitted, heard the arguments of the parties, and being otherwise advised in the premises, finds:

1. The evidence established that the Defendant took a stuffed animal (valued at \$10.49), eight T-shirts (valued at \$10 a shirt), and two jars of "Amish" peanut butter (valued at \$4.59 a jar) from the possession of the Plaintiff without the Plaintiff's consent.

Therefore it is hereby ORDERED:

- A. Judgment for the Plaintiff in the amount of \$102.67 plus court costs of \$140.00 for a total judgment of \$242.67, which shall bear interest at the rate of 11% per annum from the date of this judgment, for which let execution issue.



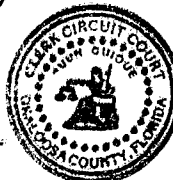
